- For senior matches, these streams are displayed publicly on YouTube and the Play Cricket app and website.
- Matches that have been scheduled for livestreaming are indicated in PlayHQ with a video camera icon.
- Recorded footage may be used for the **club/associations** promotional, educational or disciplinary purposes.
