How your club can celebrate?

- Host a free come & try day for girls and women to try cricket at your club
- Create a recognition moment at training or game day
- Create social posts from the club and players around the club, thanking the women who help at the club, giving them recognition for their roles and support
- Spotlight female volunteers and players on social media
- Share stories of women and girls in your club's history

Tips for a more inclusive Club

- A warm welcome greet every new player or family with a smile
- Visible role models promote women and girls in photos and stories, ensure equal representation across your social media platforms
- Inclusive language use 'everyone' or 'all players' instead of guys or boys
- Safe spaces provide clean change rooms and flexible uniform options
- Ask for input invite women and girls to share ideas and shape activities
